

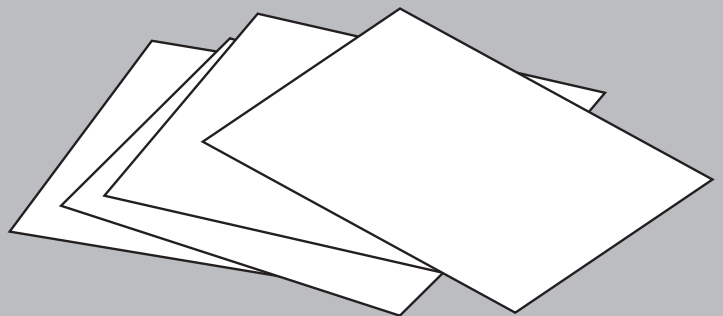
1. Get Started & Printing

What you need!

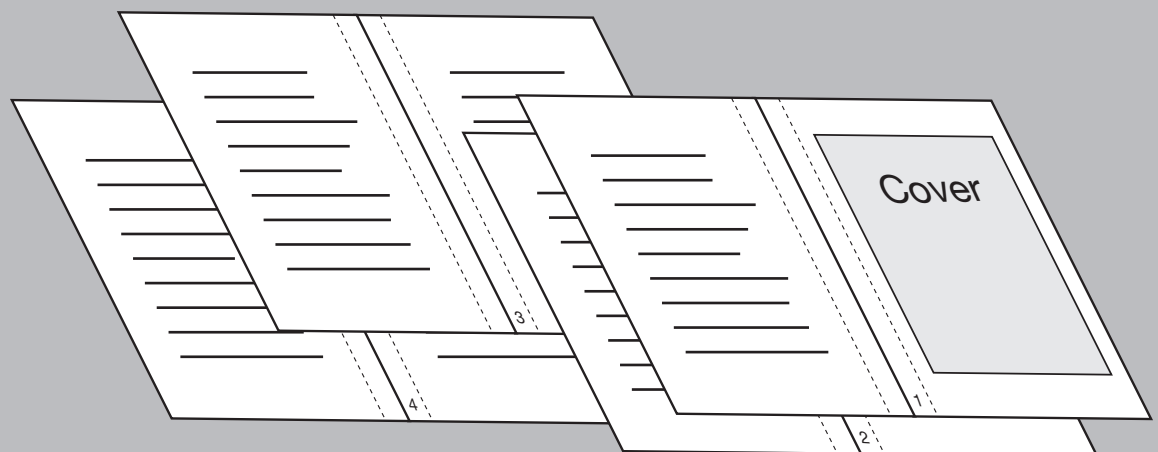
- 8.5" x 11" paper
- Printer
- Ruler
- Exacto knife or scissors (sharp scissors not kid ones)
- Stapler
- Glue
- 1" Wide tape (cloth tape is the best for the look)



- Print pdf document to 8.5x11 paper. Make sure to center the print out if you can.

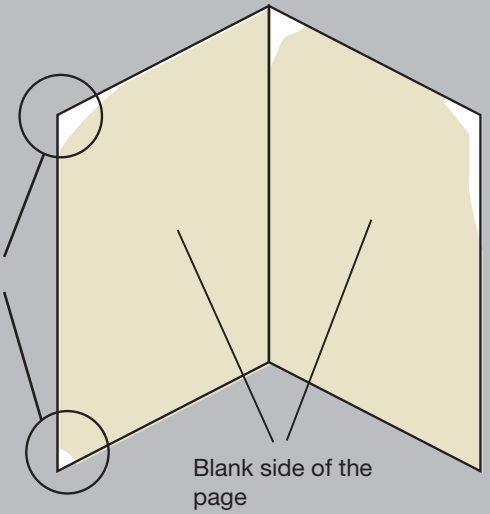


2. Fold and glue

Take your glue and paste a thin layer on the none printed side of your page. Make sure to get the entire area.

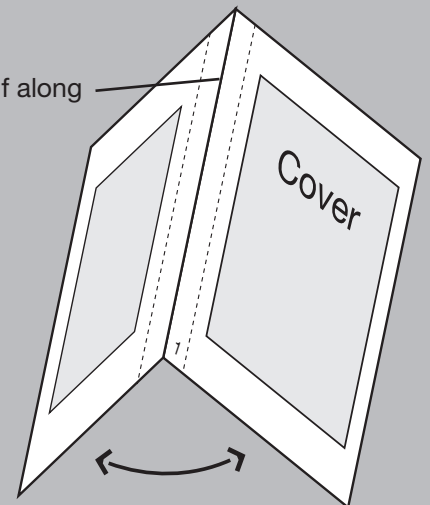
*Tip - it might be easier to pre-fold the pages first before adding the glue. This way might be less mess will folding.

*Make sure to cover all spots with glue to get a better end result

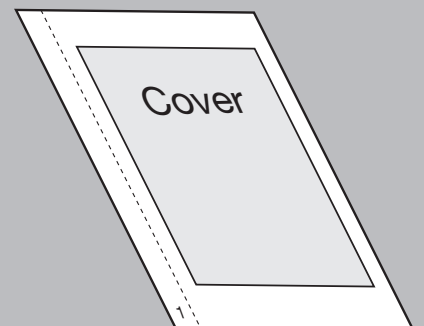


Next fold each page in half along the middle fold line, gluing the page together.

Fold the page in half along the middle fold line



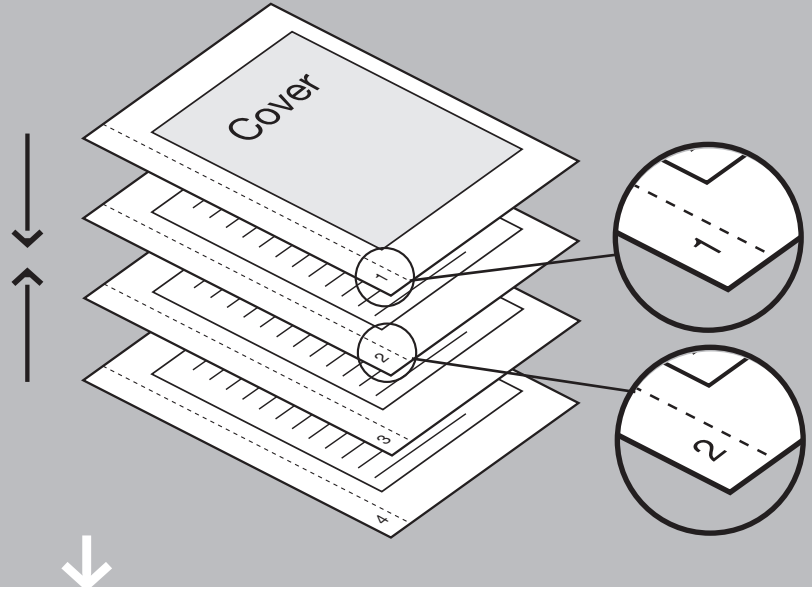

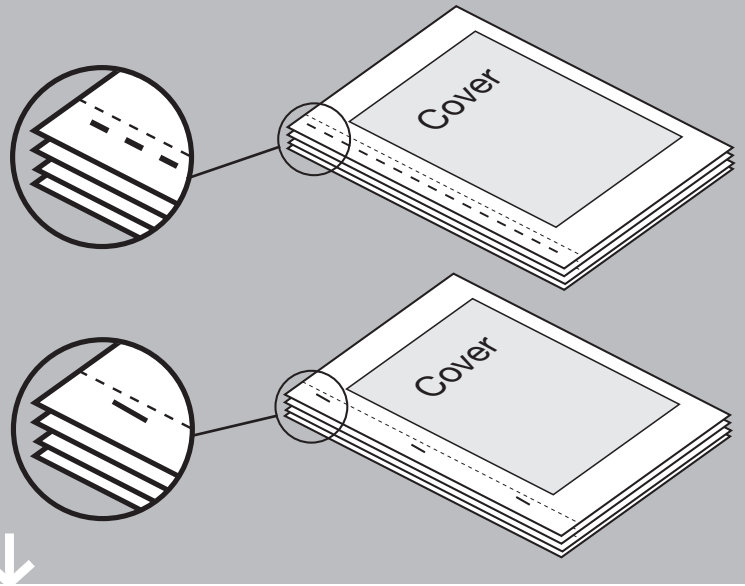
3. Combining!

In the bottom of the left corner of each page you'll see a number. Stack the page in order of the numbers (e.g. 1-10).

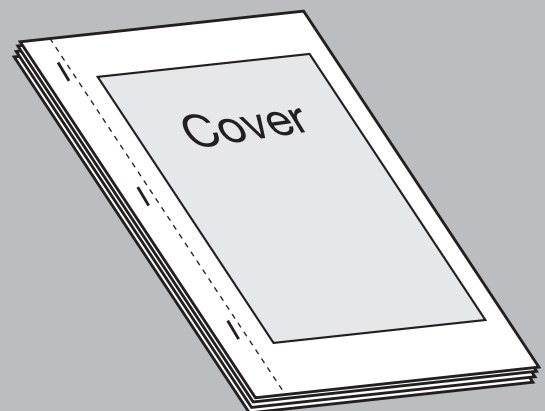
Make sure the numbering is correct before stapling!!



Staple 3 times along the edge of the left hand spine. Closer to the inside edge the better.



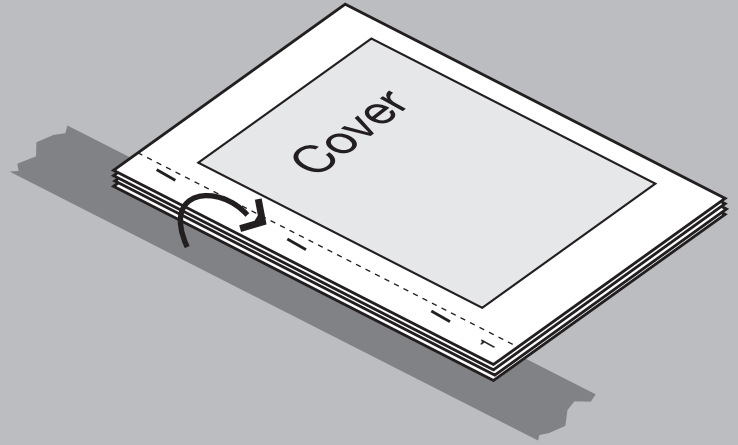

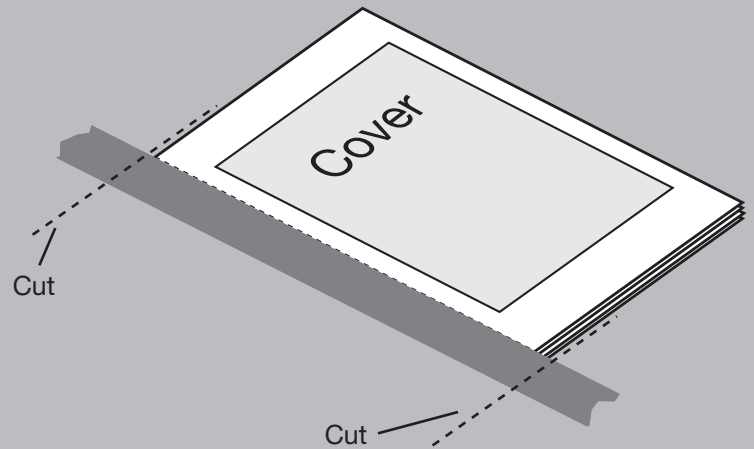
3. Taping

Tear a strip of tape longer than the books spine. Apply the tape to one side of the books spine.

Make sure to align the tape to the edge of the dotted guide line



Fold the other side of the tape over. After the tape is along the spine, cut off the excess.
